

Schneider-Long and the Leakes win US Open tourney

Brandt Schneider and Steve Long, aided by U.S. Open champion Jordan Speith, took the first flight of the Rawls U.S. Open partnership Sunday, winning by five shots over Mark and Evan Smith. A shot behind the Smiths were Rick Hancock and Rich Eberhardt. Jeff Deitiker and Jason Staggs were fourth, three shots behind Hancock-Eberhardt.

Danny and Daniel Leakes won Flight 2 with the best score of the tournament—304, topping the 314 carded by Schneider-Long in Flight 1. The Leakes won over Ron and Brendan Hettler and John Kirk and Gerald Young, who tied for second, each with a 329 total. Jeff Lansdell and Dan Conder were fourth at 330.
