

Mark Smith, John Kirk, Red Richardson dogfight winners

Mark Smith posted an even par 72 and John Kirk shot a four-over 76 to score four points better than their quotas and tie for first in the Dogfight top flight Saturday at the Rawls Course at Texas Tech.

Garry Copple carded a 77 and Wade Davenport shot an 80 to tie for third at plus one over their quotas in the first flight.

Red Richardson took the second flight with a 90, one under his quota.

Jack Lusk, with an 88, and Chuck Chapman, shooting 92, tied for second and Jim Brown, 89, and Bill Turner, 94, tied for fourth in the second flight. Lusk and Chapman were 2 below their quotas and Brown and Turner were three below.

Smith and Kirk won \$63 each and Copple and Davenport picked up \$27 each.

Richardson won \$52 for first, Lusk and Chapman, \$32 each for second, and Brown and Turner received \$6 for their fourth place tie.

There were three skins worth \$40 each for the day. Mark Smith won two and John Kirk took the other.
