

# Deitiker, Turner capture 4-12 Rawls Dogfight

Jeff Deitiker and Bill Turner won the two flights of the Rawls dogfight Saturday, but it was Mark Smith who put on a show.

Deitiker and Turner each shot plus 6 in the Stableford scoring system used in the dogfight, and Smith shot a dazzling 69 that could have been even better. Jeff's 76 on a quota of 30 was the next best medal score of the day.

Jeff collected \$52 for his first place win while Mark , battling a quota of 40, finished second with a plus 5. Rick Hancock, who shot 82, and Charles Bentley, who carded an 85, shared third place with "zeros" which matched their quotas. Mark won \$39 and Rick and Charles each collected \$14.

In the second flight, Turner won \$57 for first, Steve Bewley earned \$43 for second, Ron Hettler collected \$29 for third and Fred Smith won \$14 for fourth.

Turner's plus 6 came off a medal score of 88, same score as Bewley who had a plus 3. Hettler had an 89 for plus 1 and F. Smith shot 86 to exactly match his quota.

THE SKINS GAME in the first flight was a walkaway for Mark Smith. He won \$35 for five skins and Deitiker won the other two good for \$14.

Second flight skins, good for \$6 each, went to Steve Bewley, 2 for \$12; Ron Hettler, 2 for \$12; Jack Lusk, 2 for \$12; Fred Smith and Bill Turner, one each for \$6.
