

# Long, Bentley, M Hayden win 'dog' flights

Steve Long's one-under 71 topped the day and won the first flight of the Rawls Dogfight Saturday.

The former Texas Tech golfer topped his Stableford quota by 8 and shaded Garry Copple by two points. Jeff Deitiker was in third, three points back. Copple carded a two-over 76 and Deitiker posted a 74.

Rick Hancock and Gary Reed deadlocked for fourth, with both plus one on their quotas and a final number of 79 on their cards.

Long won \$57, Copple \$43, Deitiker 29 and the duo of Hancock and Reed split \$14. Three first flight skins of \$18 each went to Long, Copple and Reed.

**IN THE SECOND** flight, Charles Bentley shot 80 for a 7-plus over his quota. Chris Evans, 81, and Fred Smith, 82, each recorded 4-over quota to share second place. Wade Davenport and Dale Hayden each shot 82 for plus 1's to tie for fourth.

Bentley won \$47, Evans and Smith, \$29 each, and Davenport and Hayden split \$12.

Skins paid \$7 each in the second flight with Bentley winning a pair, and Davenport, Evans, Jeff Lansdell and Frank Morrison winning one each.

**IN THE THIRD** flight, Mark Hayden shot 89 for a plus-3 to edge two golfers, Dusty Thomas, 94, and Jim Brown, 90, who each had plus-2's. Steve Bewley was fourth at plus one with an 89.

Hayden won \$57 for first and Thomas and Brown each won \$43 for second. Bewley picked up \$14 for fourth.

There were seven skins in the third flight with Bewley winning two and Hayden, Brown, Bill Turner, Red Richardson and Charles Quisenberry winning one each. Each skin paid \$7.
