

# Mark Smith, Wade Davenport win 5-30 dogfight

Mark Smith scored a 4-under 68 Saturday, May 30, to easily win the first flight of the RMGA golf dogfight at the Rawls Course.

The round added up to 46 points, or 10 more than the quota set for Smith, and his total easily beat his closest pursuer, Charles Bentley, who posted an 80 for a plus 3.

**In the second flight**, Wade Davenport carded an 80 for 30 points and topped his quota by 10 to beat four players who tied for second, each with plus 3's.

Smith collected \$57 for the first flight victory. Bentley won \$43 for second and two golfers who tied for third, Jeff Deitiker, 79, and Kyle Shuman, 79, each won \$21.

Davenport won \$57 for his second flight victory and the four who tied for second each won \$21. They were Jim Brown with an 88, Gerald Myers, also 88; Fred Smith, 86; and Gary Moore, also 86.

**First Flight Skins**-Mark Smith, two good for a total of \$36, and Brandt Schneider, a single good for \$18.

**Second Flight Skins**-Wade Davenport and Gerald Myers, two each good for \$10 apiece; plus single skins worth \$5 each for Dale Hayden, Stan Schmidt, Gary Moore, Chuck Chapman, Jim Brown, Fred Smith and Frank Morrison.
