

# Robin Evans, Ron Hettler win 6-21 Dog Fight

As far as the men who play in the Saturday dog fights at the Rawls Course are concerned, they hear the footsteps.

Robin Evans is here, and she's taking over.

Robin won the June 21 dogfight, the only lady among 20 men. She recorded a plus 2 over her quota in the Stableford points game with a solid 87 and that was good for first place in the first flight. She won \$52 for her efforts.

It was Robin's second consecutive victory in the Saturday dog fights. In the previous event on June 7, Robin shot 78 for the best score of the year by any one vs. quota, plus 14, and won by seven points.

This time three male golfers by the names of Frank Morrison, Gary Reed and Gary Moore tied for second, each with zero points, which means they shot exactly their quotas. Reed turned in a 77, Moore a 79 and Morrison an 87. They won \$26 apiece.

**IN THE SECOND FLIGHT**, Ron Hettler won \$62 for first place with a plus 6 over his quota. He shot a solid 84 to beat out three players who tied for second. They were Dale Hayden, Mark Hayden and Red Richardson, who each finished at plus 2. Dale shot 86, Mark 91 and Red 90 and they each won \$31 for their shares.

First flight skins, worth \$6 each, were led by Robin Evans, who won a pair. Winning single skins were Gary Reed, Gary Moore, Curtis Borland, Chris Evans, Kyle Shuman and Randy Stumbo.

Second flight skins, worth \$12 each, were led by Red Richardson, who won two. Single skin winners were Ron Hettler, Mark Hayden and Chuck Chapman.
