

Long, Myers sweep Rawls' 6-28 Dog Fight

Steve Long fashioned a two-under 70 and Gerald Myers shot a best-ever round of 84 at the Rawls Course at Texas Tech Saturday to take top honors in the RMGA's weekly dog fight.

Long topped his quota of 35 by 7 in the Stableford points game to win the first flight. Myers won the second flight by scoring 27 points, 11 above his 16 quota.

Second place in the first flight was shared by three golfers, Rick Hancock (81), Curtis Borland (78) and Landon Lewis (81). Each scored 1 above quota.

Long won \$52 for first and the three second-place finishers each won \$26. First flight skins, worth \$7 each, went to Gary Reed and Mark Smith, two each; Jeff Deitiker, Rick Hancock and Steve Long, one each.

Myers was a runaway winner in the second flight. Dale Hayden (85) and Charles Bentley (83) shared second place with plus 4's. Brandon Ripley (80) won fourth with a plus 3.

Myers won \$47 for first, Hayden and Bentley won \$29 each for second and Ripley collected \$12 for fourth. Second flight skins, worth \$7.50 each, went to Hayden, Myers and Ripley, all with two each.
