

# Shuman tops 7-19 dog fight, 4 deadlock for 1<sup>st</sup> in 2<sup>nd</sup> flight

Kyle Shuman's one-over 73 gave him a plus 6 to top Jeff Deitiker's plus 4 off the same score in the first flight of the RMGA's dog fight at Rawls Saturday.

The competition was equally keen in the second flight when four golfers deadlocked for first place. The four winners were Robin Evans, Jim Brown, Charles Quisenberry and Bill Turner, each with plus 3 above their quotas. Evans shot 85, Brown 88, Quisenberry 90 and Turner 92.

**IN THE FIRST FLIGHT**, Schuman won \$57 for first place and Deitiker picked up \$43 for second.

Chris Evans (79) and Rich Eberhardt (81) each scored plus 2's to share third place. They won \$21 each for the tie.

Eberhardt also won three skins worth \$18 total. Steve Long, who also shot 73, won a pair of skins worth \$12, and four others won \$6 each for single skins. They were Deitiker, Gary Moore, Shuman and Ross Valigura.

**IN THE SECOND FLIGHT**, the winners -- R. Evans, Brown, Quisenberry and Turner -- collected \$35 each for their share of first place.

The \$54 skins pot was split two ways. Quisenberry tacked on another \$36 for a pair of skins and Brown won an additional \$18 for a single.
