

Moore, Quisenberry win 7-5 Dog Fight

Gary Moore carded a 79 good for a plus 5 over his quota to win the first flight and Charles Quisenberry shot 87 for a plus 8 to win the second at the RMGA Saturday Dog Fight.

Moore edged out two golfers who recorded plus 2's to tie for second, Brant Schneider (74) and Lynn Davis (80). Garry Copple shot 82 to finish fourth with a zero, which exactly matched quota. Moore received \$62 for the victory, Schneider and Davis won \$39 each and Copple received \$16 for the final money spot.

Skins winners in the first flight were Rick Hancock, 2 good for \$24 total, and Copple, Moore and Schneider, one each for \$12 apiece.

Quisenberry's plus 8 won the second flight by a point over Dale Hayden, who shot 81 for a plus 7. Third place was a tie between Chris Evans (79) and Charles Bentley (84), who both recorded plus 6. Quisenberry received \$73 for first, Hayden won \$55 for second and Evans and Bentley won \$27 each for their tie for third.

Second Flight skins, worth \$8 each, went to Dale Hayden, 2 good for \$16; Bentley, Quisenberry, Jim Brown, Jerry Smith, Fred Smith and Jeff Lansdell, each with one for \$8.
