

Garry Copple, Brandon Ripley top dog fight

Garry Copple fired a par 72 round at the Rawls Course Saturday (8-2-14) to win the first flight of the weekly dog fight at the Texas Tech course.

Brandon Ripley had a fine round of his own, a 3-over 75, to capture the second flight.

Copple scored 38 points in the modified Stableford scoring system used by the RMGA in the Saturday points game. That was 7 above his quota. Ripley had an even better scoring day for his quota, finishing 9 above with a total of 34 points.

Second place in the first flight went to Chris Evans with a 78 good for 4 over quota. Third was a tie between Curtis Borland (73) and Gary Reed (77), with each finishing at plus 3.

Robin Evans was second in the second flight with a plus 7 on a round of 81. Mark Hayden was third with a 90 good for plus 4 and Jerry Smith finished fourth with an 87 for plus 3.

In the first flight, Copple won \$57 for first, C. Evans \$43 for second, and Borland and Reed each won \$21 for their share of third. Second flight payoffs were \$52 for Ripley's win, \$39 for R. Evans' second spot, \$26 for Hayden's third and \$13 for Smith's fourth place.

First flight skins at \$6 each went to Borland, Reed and Chad Hanchey, two each; and Copple and Steve Long, one apiece.

In the second flight, there were five skins worth \$10 each. They went to R. Evans, M. Hayden, Ripley, Ron Hettler and Dusty Thomas, one each.
