

Gary Moore takes Sunday dog fight at Rawls

Gary Moore won an abbreviated one-flight RMGA dog fight at the Rawls Course Sunday morning. Gary shot a solid 78 on the par 72 Texas Tech course. He scored 31 points to top his quota by 4 and edge second place finisher Gerald Myers by 3.

Gerald shot 92 for 17 points, one over his quota to capture second by one over Rich Eberhardt and Mark Hayden, who each matched their quotas for zero's. Rich shot 79 for 30 points and Mark shot 92 for 16, each reaching the exact number of his quota.

First place was worth \$57 to Moore and second brought \$43 to Myers. Eberhardt and Hayden each won \$21 for their tie for third.

There were six skins worth \$9 each on the day, with Jeff Deitiker winning a pair good for \$18 and the other four split at \$9 each for Kyle Shuman, Rich Eberhardt, Steve Long and Gerald Myers.
