

Steve Long's 69, Jack Lusk's 83 win flights at Saturday, 8-9, dog fight at Rawls Course

Steve Long scored a 3-under 69 to win the first flight of the RMGA's Saturday dog fight, racking up 44 points to beat his quota by 7.

Jack Lusk shot 83 to win the second flight, scoring 28 points, a plus 9 over his quota.

Both winners received \$62 first prizes.

IN THE FIRST FLIGHT, Jeff Deitiker finished second after posting a 73, good for a plus 6 over his quota. Frank Morrison with an 81 finished at plus 3 for third and Mark Smith shot 74 for plus 2 to win fourth. Deitiker won \$47 for second, Morrison took home \$31 for third and Smith received \$16 for fourth.

First flight skins worth \$15 each went to Deitiker, Kyle Shuman, Fred Smith and Mark Smith.

IN THE SECOND FLIGHT, Chuck Chapman shot 89 for a plus 7 and won \$47 for second place. Third went to Bobby Gleason, who shot 89 for a plus 4, good for \$31. Tying for fourth were Jeff Lansdell (85) and Bill Turner (91), good for plus 3's and \$8 for each.

Second flight skins worth \$10 each went to Chapman, \$10; Lansdell, \$30 for three; and Lusk, \$20 for two.
