

Ross Valigura, Steve Bewley tops in 7-12 Dog Fight

Ross Valigura posted a solid 81 good for a plus 6 above quota to win the first flight and Steve Bewley carded a nice 84 good for a plus 8 to take the second Saturday at the Rawls Course dog fight.

Valigura edged Chris Evans, who shot 79 for plus 5 and Garry Copple and Curtis Borland, who each recorded plus 2's with rounds of 77 and 74, respectively. Ross collected \$62 for first, Chris took \$47 for second and Garry and Curtis each won \$23 for their share of third place.

First flight skins worth \$8 each went to Curtis Borland and Ross Valigura, each with a pair, and Jeff Deitiker, Chris Evans and Kyle Shuman, each with a single.

IN THE SECOND FLIGHT, Jerry Smith also shot 84 to finish closest to Bewley. Jerry's round was good for plus 5 and shaded Jim Brown and Charles Quisenberry, who each had plus 3's with rounds of 88 and 93, respectively.

Bewley won \$57 for first place, Smith took home \$43 for second and Brown and Quisenberry each collected \$21 for their tie for third.

Second flight skins worth \$11 each went to Jerry Smith with three good for \$33 along with singles for Quisenberry and Red Richardson.
